

The following is a summary of the current status of the project construction and the activities that will be occurring over the next few weeks.

Construction Status

- **Highway 101 is closed to traffic from Highway 61 to Lakota Lane.** Please follow the signed detour route.
- Excavation and grading activities are occurring along Highway 101.
- The box culvert installation north of the Highway 61 roundabout has been completed.
- Water main and sanitary sewer north of the Highway 61 roundabout is under construction.
- Private utilities (gas, electric, etc.) are relocating their facilities.

Planned Construction Activities

- Excavation and grading activities will continue along Highway 101.
- Retaining walls at the box culvert will be constructed.
- The Creekwood Drive cul de sac and Lakota Lane connection roadway will be paved.
- Sanitary sewer, water main and storm sewer construction will continue.
- **Highway 101 will remain closed to traffic from Highway 61 to Lakota Lane.**

The City of Chanhassen and Carver County are working with our contractors and other partners to complete our construction projects safely and responsibly. Work is being conducted in accordance with guidelines related to COVID-19 to the maximum extent possible, including social distancing and hygiene.
