

The following is a summary of the current status of the project construction and the activities that will be occurring over the next few weeks.

Construction Status

- **Highway 101 is closed to traffic from Highway 61 to Creekwood Drive.**
- Excavation and grading activities are occurring along Highway 101.
- The pedestrian bridge construction over Bluff Creek has been placed.
- Sanitary sewer, water main and storm sewer construction is ongoing.
- *Please note that MnDOT has detoured Highway 41 traffic to Highway 101 and Highway 61 due to another construction project.*

Planned Construction Activities

- On-site grading activities will continue along Highway 101.
- Sanitary sewer, water main and storm sewer construction will continue.
- Additional concrete median and curb and gutter work will occur on Highway 101.
- Work will continue on the HCRRA trail pedestrian bridge over Highway 101.
- **Highway 101 will remain closed to traffic from Highway 61 to Creekwood Drive.**

The City of Chanhassen and Carver County are working with our contractors and other partners to complete our construction projects safely and responsibly. Work is being conducted in accordance with guidelines related to COVID-19 to the maximum extent possible, including social distancing and hygiene.
