

The following is a summary of the current status of the project construction and the activities that will be occurring over the next few weeks.

Current Construction Status

- **Highway 101 remains closed to traffic from Highway 61 to Creekwood Drive**
- Bituminous paving on Highway 101 is complete.
- Highway 61 pavement striping is complete and all lanes are open to traffic.
- Work on the HCCRA trail pedestrian bridge continues.
- Grading and restoration work along Highway 101 continues.

Planned Construction Activities

- Pavement striping and sign installation along Highway 101 will be completed.
- Highway 101 will be opened to traffic mid-day on November 9th.
- The HCRRA trail pedestrian bridge will be completed and the trail will be opened to the west of Highway 101 mid-day on November 9th.
- The contractor will be completing various off pavement work to finish out 2020.

The City of Chanhassen and Carver County are working with our contractors and other partners to complete our construction projects safely and responsibly. Work is being conducted in accordance with guidelines related to COVID-19 to the maximum extent possible, including social distancing and hygiene.
