

## **Emergency Services During Construction**

On April 12<sup>th</sup>, the Highway 101 Improvements project will begin. In order to provide for the most timely emergency services response for those residents and businesses to the south of the closure, the Chanhassen Fire Department and Carver County Sheriff's Office have prepared for a response to this area that includes response by Chaska Fire and Chaska Police as well. With the partnership of these two agencies, along with Ridgeview Ambulance, we have created a response plan to ensure adequate, timely resources responding to 911 calls through the duration of construction. Carver County Dispatch will preprogram systems that alert the proper agencies depending on the type of call and the location. A call from a home or business to 911 sets the plan in motion--without the need to do anything differently.

The Carver County Sheriff's Office and the Chanhassen Fire Department will still be responding to all calls; however, depending on the urgency of the call, other public safety partners may also respond to shorten our overall response to the emergency. Ridgeview Ambulance will likely be responding from Chaska rather than from Lake Ann Park for calls to the area. As the customer, you may see a different name on the door but can expect the same professional service.
