

The following is a summary of the current status of the project construction and the activities that will be occurring over the next few weeks.

## Current Construction Status (Phase 2A)

- Highway 101 is closed to traffic from Creekwood Drive to The Mustard Seed. Access to The Mustard Seed is from the north. Access to Bluff Creek Golf Course is from the south. Please follow the signed detour route around this area.
- Grading, excavation and private utility relocation activities are occurring.
- The HCRRA trail is open for use through the project area.

## Planned Construction Activities

- Grading and excavation activities will continue on Highway 101 north of Creekwood Drive.
- Utility crews will begin installation of sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer north of Creekwood Drive.
- Private utility companies will continue their relocation efforts.
- Phase 2B, which is the remaining section of Highway 101 north of The Mustard Seed, is currently scheduled to begin in July 2021.
